



CM 06-06 Stage # 1 Golden Bullet Standards

RULES: USPSA Rule Book, Current Edition

COURSE DESIGNER: NorCal Section

START POSITION: Standing in Box A, facing targets, hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

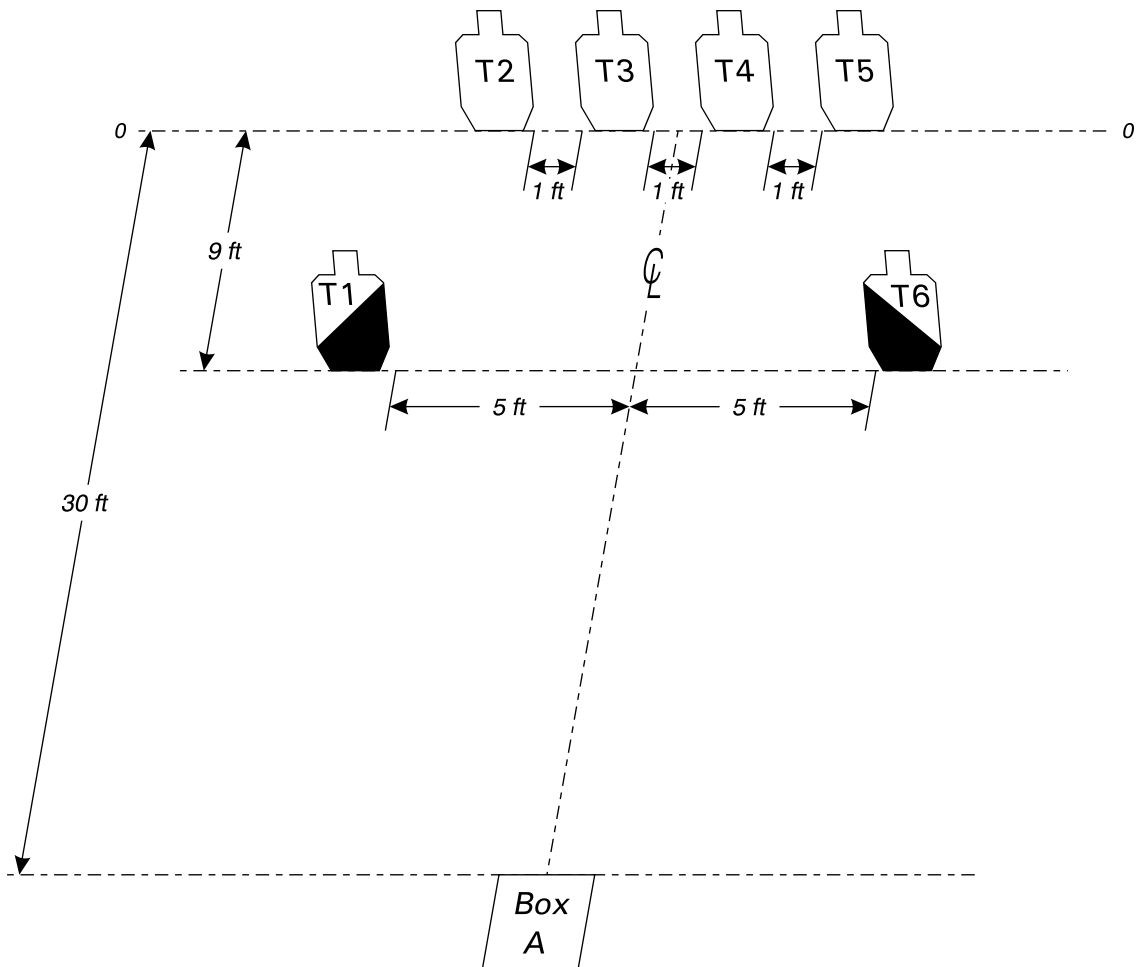
STAGE PROCEDURE

- String 1 On signal, engage targets with one round each, perform a mandatory reload and re-engage each target with one round each strong hand only.
- String 2 On signal, engage each target with one round each, perform a mandatory reload and re-engage each target with one round each weak hand only.

For both strings, all rounds fired must be from within Box A.

SCORING

- SCORING:** Virginia Count, 24 rounds, 120 points
- TARGETS:** 6 IPSC
- SCORED HITS:** Best 4/paper
- START - STOP:** Audible - Last shot
- PENALTIES:** Per current edition of USPSA Rule Book. One procedural per shot fired for failing to reload when specified.



SETUP NOTES: Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Box A is 3 feet by 3 feet. Hard cover on T1 and T6 runs diagonally from lower shoulder to top of angled cut at the bottom.

Long and Short of It

Starting Position: Competitor is standing inside the shooting area, facing UP RANGE, toes touching the two "X" marks on the farthest up range fault line, arms hanging naturally by the sides.

Gun Ready Condition: Competitor's loaded gun is holstered per USPSA Handgun Competition Rules (latest edition)

Stage Procedure: On signal, engage all targets as they become visible from within the shooting area.

Scoring: Comstock,
24 rounds, 120 points

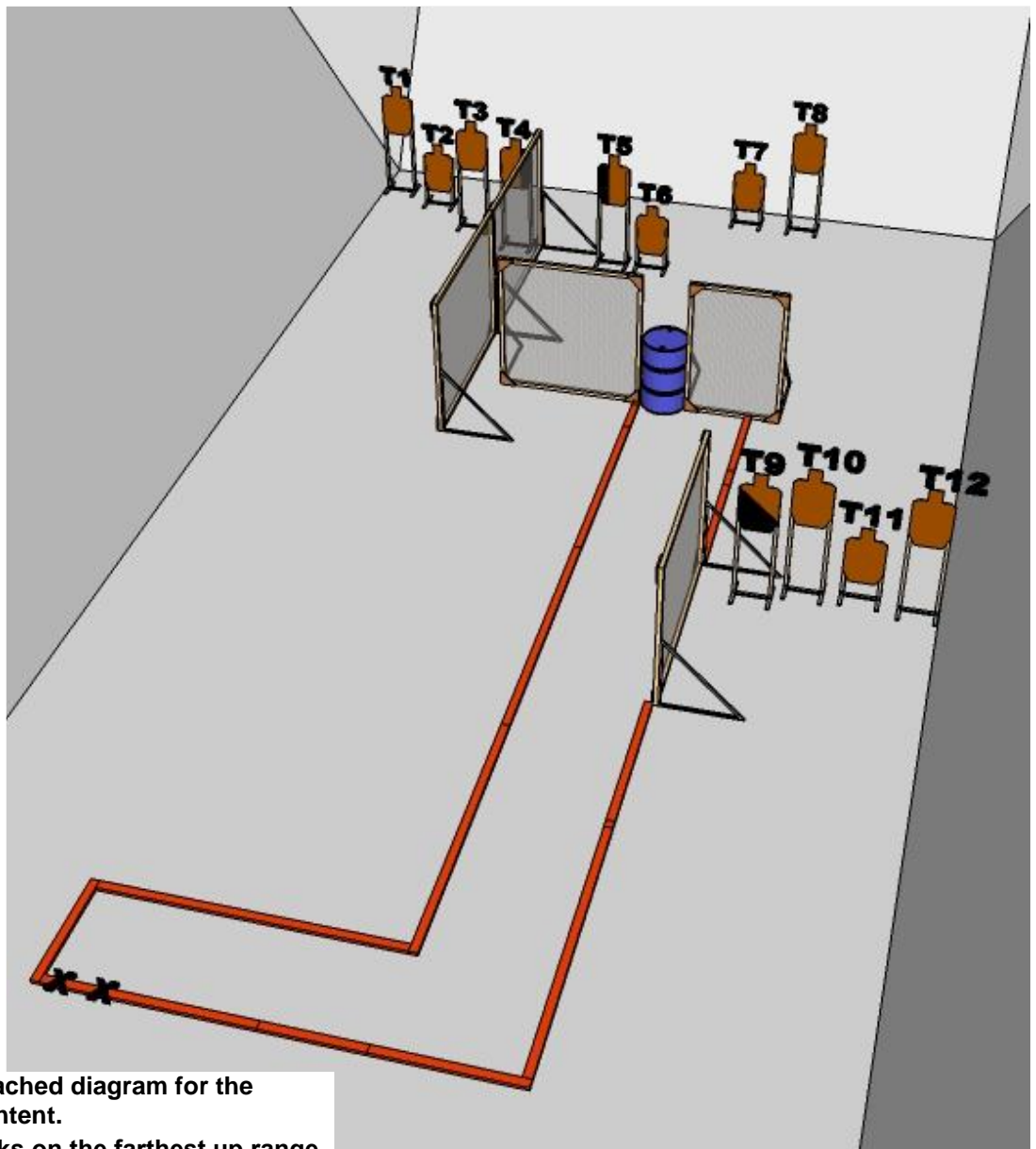
Targets: 12 Metric Targets

Scored Hits: Best 2 per Metric Target

Start-Stop: Audible - Last shot

Penalties: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10

Rules: USPSA Current Edition



Setup Notes: see attached diagram for the approximate design intent.

- Place two "X" marks on the farthest up range fault line at the far left as shown in diagram.



Stage # 3
Adds Up

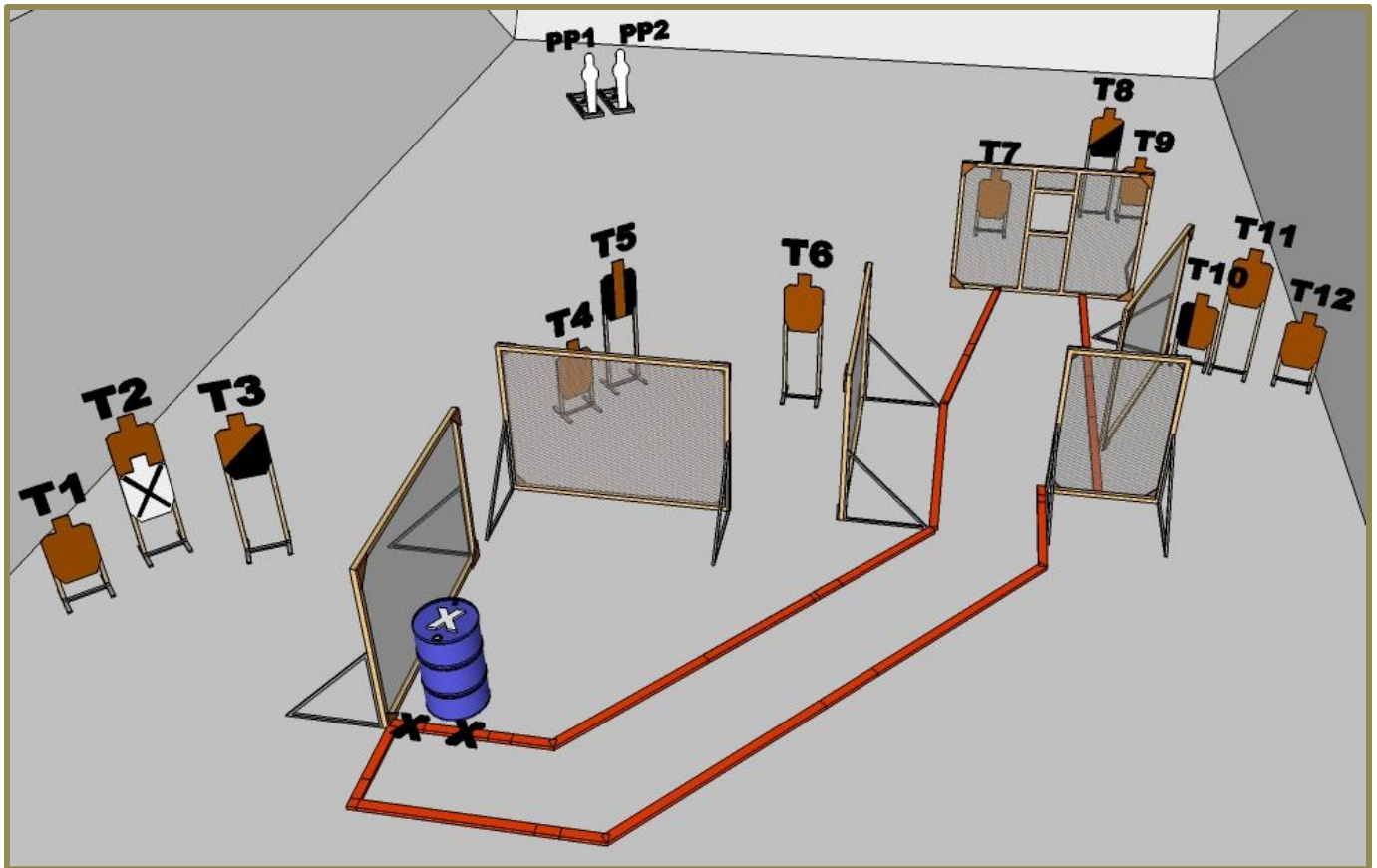

Starting Position: Competitor is standing inside the shooting area with toes touching the two "X" marks on the fault line up range of the barrel, arms hanging naturally by the sides.

Gun Ready Condition: The competitor's loaded gun is placed pointing down range on the "X" mark on the top of the barrel near the up range wall.

Stage Procedure: On signal, engage all targets as they become visible from within the shooting area.

Scoring: Comstock,
26 rounds, 130 points
Targets: 12 Metric Targets
2 Pepper Poppers
Scored Hits: Best 2 per Metric Target
Steel Down = 1A
Start-Stop: Audible - Last shot
Penalties: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Rules: USPSA Current Edition



Set up Notes:

- Place steel at least 30 feet away from the nearest fault line(s).
- Place an "X" marks on the top of the barrel near the center as shown in the diagram above.

Tight Squeeze

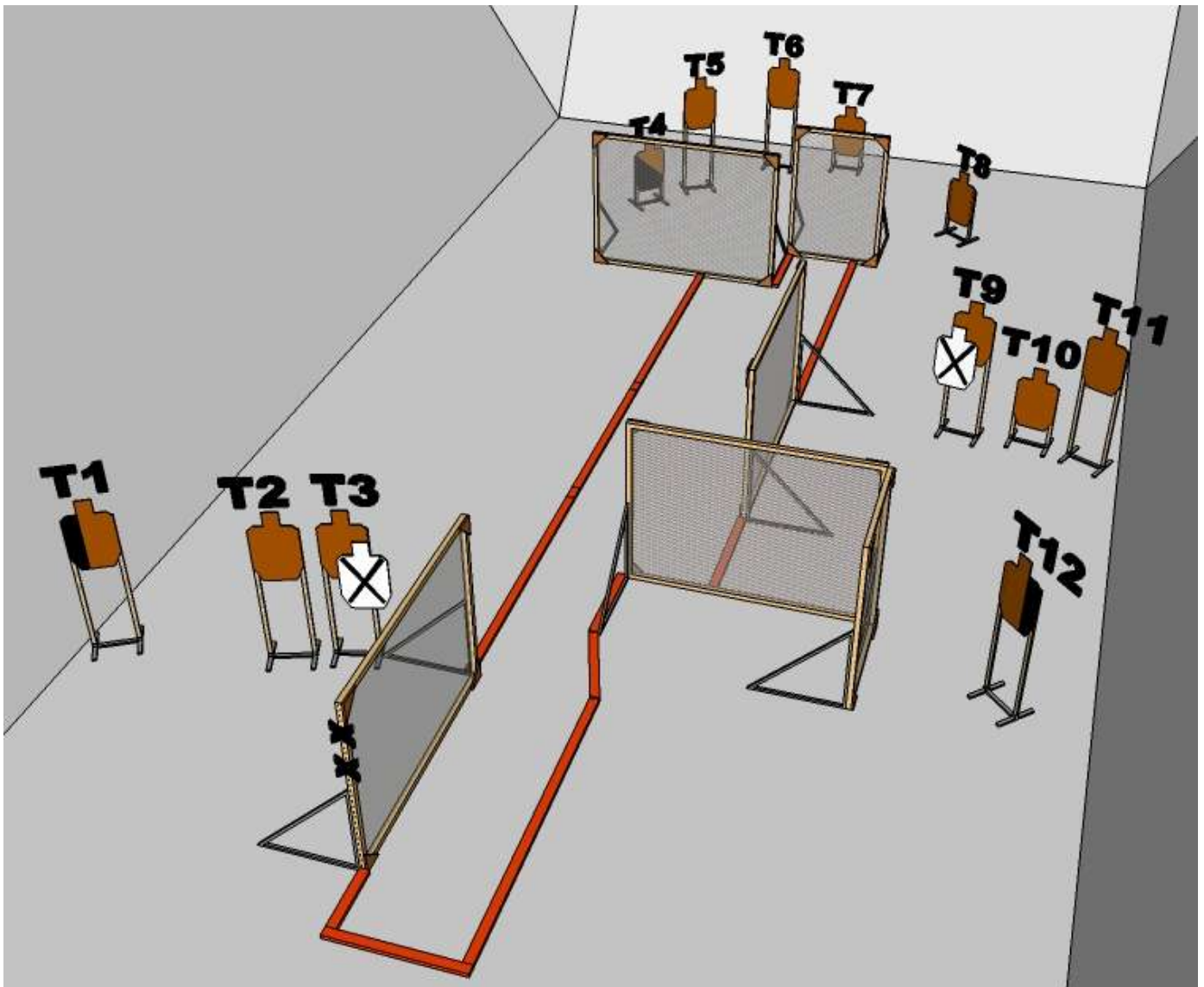

Starting Position: The competitor is standing inside the shooting area, touching the two "X" marks on the up range wall with both hands.

Gun Ready Condition: Competitor's loaded gun is holstered per USPSA Handgun Competition Rules (latest edition).

Stage Procedure: On signal, engage all targets as they become visible from within the shooting area.

Scoring: Comstock, 24 rounds, 120 points
Targets: 12 Metric Targets
Scored Hits: Best 2 per Metric Target
Start-Stop: Audible - Last shot
Penalties: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Rules: USPSA Current Edition



Set up Notes: See attached setup notes for approximate design intent

- Place two "X" marks on the farthest up range edge of the farthest up range wall.

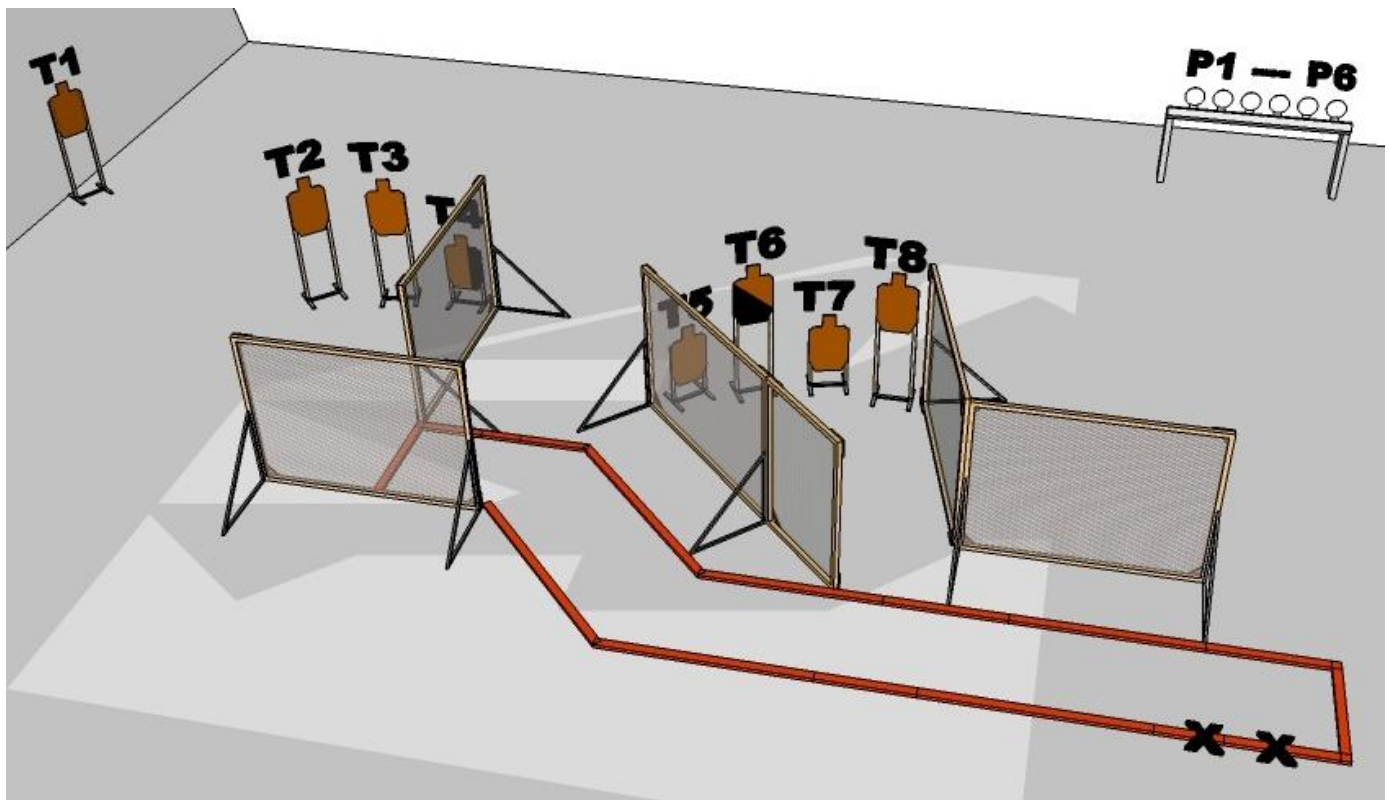
Plates N' Eight

Starting Position: Standing in the shooting area, toes touching the two "X" marks on the up range fault line, arms hanging naturally by the sides.	Scoring: Comstock, 22 rounds, 110 points
Gun Ready Condition: The competitor's loaded gun is holstered per USPSA Handgun Competition Rules (latest edition)	Targets: 8 Metric Targets, 6 Round Metal Plates
Stage Procedure: On signal, engage all targets as they become visible from within the shooting area.	Scored Hits: Best 2 per Metric Target Steel Down = 1A
	Start-Stop: Audible - Last shot
	Penalties: Procedural. -10 No-shoot hit. -10
	Rules: USPSA Current Edition



Set up Notes:

- Set steel at least 30 ft down range of the nearest fault line.
- Place two "X" marks on the farthest up range fault line approximately as shown in the diagram above.
